



## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS 2023 JASON A. HANNAH MEDAL (HISTORY OF MEDICINE)

### Description

The medal is awarded for an important Canadian publication in the history of medicine. In this context, the word “Canadian” refers to the citizenship or residence of the author, or to content clearly relevant to Canadian medicine and health care. The award is made for a book published in the five years preceding its nomination.

### Prize

A bronze medal and a cash award of \$1,500 are offered if there is a suitable nomination.

### Eligibility

- A book nominated for this medal must have been published between the last five years 2018 - 2022
- The book must be a Canadian publication
- Candidates shall be a Canadian citizen or have had a status for at last three years as a Canadian permanent resident at the time of their nomination

### Required elements

Nominations dossiers must include the following items below:

- RSC Nomination Form
- Letter from the Nominator (Fellow, Institutional or College Members of the RSC, Publisher or other (self-nominations are not accepted)
- Seven (7) copies of the book

*\*\*\*Nominators can submit up to three nominations.*

### Submit

The complete nomination package must be submitted by email to [nominations@rsc-src.ca](mailto:nominations@rsc-src.ca) by **March 31, 2023**.

Winners will be contacted in the summer months. The official announcement from the RSC will be issued in September.
