In May, when I wrote with a series of updates on the RSC's organizational response to COVID-19, I emphasized my gratitude to the many colleagues who supported these efforts. I would like to repeat this sentiment, thanking those RSC members who have ensured the success of our ongoing activities. The highlights of recent achievements, both anticipated and unanticipated, can be found in this edition of our eNews.

With respect to the COVID-19 activities, I would like to recognize the commitment of Tom Marrie and the members of Task Force, which has resulted in an impressive number of excellent publications and Policy Briefings. The response to the three rounds of our survey to members has also been most impressive. This degree of engagement supports the Board's decision to approve a budget for this fiscal year that supports our continued focus on Canada's response to and recovery from COVID-19.

I must also acknowledge the devoted work of numerous members, as well the Walter House staff, as their dedication ensured the election of new members and the selection of candidates for the RSC awards proceeded on-time.
